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Dr. Joseph Peck: Welcome everyone to the Family ID Q&A session. This is a follow-up session to the free webinar that Greg Gunn did on June 23rd. That was outstanding. The title of it was, “The Power of a Family Vision,” and I've been thinking about how important this is. We know how important it is. **I know as a destiny coach**, as a prophetic destiny coach, **how important identity and destiny are to individuals**, but **what Greg is talking about is Family ID identity**. Who are you as a family? Who did God create you to be? And what is the purpose of your family?

The #1 time-waster for individuals by far—by far, that costs people, on average, more than \$1 million during their lifetime—I mean, that's a lot of money if you tally up the number of people. The number one time-waster **is not living on purpose**.

Well, **what do you suppose the #1 one time-waster is for families?** *Not knowing their purpose, not knowing who they are in Christ, who God created them to be as a family, and what their purpose is.* And not only that, not knowing who you are as a family, what your family values are, what your mission is. What your vision is causes conflict, because you have different people going different directions.

So **how many of you have had significant conflict in your families?** Can I see a show of hands? We all can raise our hands here. I can raise both my hands. It's a major-league issue.

(And) **the day after we did the free webinar with Greg, I woke up and I received such a download in my spirit, I journaled it.** But I was hearing. God was revealing lead dominoes to multiply this message throughout the earth. This is so important because we've heard about the seven mountains that shape culture, the seven spheres of influence that shape culture—business, education, government, family,

arts and entertainment, media, the church. Well, of all those, **the foundation of all those mountains, is the family mountain.** As the family goes, so goes the nation. It is the foundation. Family is the first institution ordained by God, ordained in the Garden of Eden, so we know that it's fundamental.

So **what Greg is teaching is**—oh, my gosh—it's **so important.**

We're going to have a prayer, and then I'm going to ask Greg to just share a few stories about families that have been radically transformed by what he teaches in some of the countries he's been in.

Then we're going to answer some of the questions that people have submitted in the chat from June 23rd. But if you have a question, you can type it in the chat at any point. You can type it in the chat now; you can type it in at any point during this discussion here.

I'm going to ask Shelli Miller to say our opening prayer here, and then I'm going to call on Greg.

Shelli Miller: Heavenly Father, we're so thankful that You have called us together to be here today. Lord, just us being here, and hearing what Greg has to share with us, and answers to questions he's going to give, Father, is going to move families forward in unity and purpose, Lord, to get families on-purpose. And Lord, even if it's just a bare beginning, that is enormous. That is of absolute importance, Lord, because we want to have Kingdom families. We want to have families where every individual knows who he or she is in Christ, how they're supposed to be playing that out in life, what their destiny is, and how they're going to go forward.

Lord, we just thank You. So many of us muddled around for a long time. We muddled this way and we muddled that way—but no longer, Lord. No longer. We're on the laser focus now.

We thank You that Greg's going to help us get there, that he has great wisdom and understanding to impart to us. We ask You for the anointing of Your Holy Spirit upon him today as he shares, and upon our ears so that we have ears to hear what You're saying, Holy Spirit. Help us so that we can take this in and make it an application in

our personal lives, in our family's lives. We just ask You for these things, Lord Jesus. In Your name, amen.

Greg Gunn: Amen. Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Amen. Thank you, Shelli Miller. Well, Bonnie, you can spotlight Greg when he speaks here.

Greg, I mentioned in the green room that I was going to ask you to share a few stories of families—a few families—that have been radically transformed by the teaching that you do.

Greg Gunn: Yes, man, fantastic. Thank you, Dr. Peck, and all of you that are here today. I'm so excited about what God is doing to help families become more intentional today than they were yesterday, more intentional this year than they were last year.

I just want to share with you about a family. This was a family whose **grandfather was a judge**, and he was so excited about the prospect of getting all of his family members, his adult children and their spouses, to participate in this Family ID, and helping them develop their multi-generational family mission, vision, and values.

So he began to think and pray about, "How can I get my family together in a place where they would actually want to show up?" Okay? Of course him knowing his children and grandchildren and knowing their spouses, he came up with this incredible idea to schedule a family vacation where they would all go to the islands of Hawaii as a family.

He, of course, was financially in a position where he could afford to invite all of the family members to Hawaii, to this beautiful property. And he said, "Hey, what we're going to do, I'm inviting you all to come. We're going to have the most fun. We've got this thing so planned out to go and spend time at the beach and have so much fun. We're going to do a zip line and all this other stuff," whatever activities they came up with. And he said, "Each evening we're going to sit down together and we're going to work on writing our family mission statement and work on our family core values. I want every one of you to participate in this process, because I want to create this multi-generational family vision to pass every generation." So he did it.

In fact, each year, they set it up. **This became an annual family tradition to go away at some location where they would work on this vision statement and mission.** And then they would spend the entire year. Each family would pick a topic like world hunger or homelessness, or whenever a particular problem that was being dealt with in their community, or a particular problem that just kept being a continuous problem, either in their family or in their community. They would spend that whole year praying over that, and then coming and presenting to the family what things God had revealed to them about the cure to that particular problem. This started a multi-generational tradition where the children and the grandchildren and the aunts and the uncles would all come together once a year.

So this family and the judge and his wife said, "**We spent the whole year thinking of ways to make this trip the most attractive, the most fun, so that the children would come back every year and the grandchildren would say, 'It's the funnest thing we ever did growing up.**" I would never miss one of these family trips, this family get-together. I would never miss it. It was the funnest thing we ever did. Oh, I got to spend so much time with my cousins, I got to spend time with my aunts and my uncles."

I just want to say to you, grandparents—**grandmothers and grandfathers, you have more influence in your little finger than mom and dad have in their whole body.** You do. I'm telling you.

Oh my goodness, you **aunts and uncles, you have no idea how you've got a niece or a nephew out there that is secretly looking up to you** and thinking, "I want to be like them when I grow up." You have no idea. You don't. You don't think for one minute about this little niece or nephew, okay? You don't think they're listening, or you don't think they're interested. In fact, their body language might show that they have zero interest, okay? But you know what? They are so interested, you cannot imagine.

I've said this. My mother is one of seven siblings, and each of her siblings married a wonderful Christian. And so my aunts and my uncles are all believers. And whenever we got together when I was growing up, when we got together for Thanksgiving, when we got together for whatever holiday, I'm telling you, as a child, even though I didn't appear to be interested, I was listening to every conversation. I was laughing at every joke, because I'm telling you, my aunts and uncles were all just funny, funny people, okay? They were all very wonderful Christians. Most of them were very successful in

whatever their vocation was. They were very successful, so I would look up to them. And I'm telling you. To this very day, if one of my aunts or uncles were to ever call me up and say, "Greg, I've been praying for you," I would have passed out. "You've been praying for me?" "Yes, been praying for you. The Lord has revealed something to me that I would like to share it with you. Would you have lunch with me?"

After I picked myself up off the floor from having passed out, I would have said, "Yes, that would be the most important meeting. I would never miss that meeting—you just have no idea. I'll drop everything to come meet with you."

Now I can just tell you, not one of them would have thought to do that because they've got busy lives, they've got children of their own and grandchildren, whatever. But I'm telling you, if they were to ask me to come and meet with them, I would do it. So I want you to know you've got more influence in your little finger than mom and dad have in their whole body in certain areas. And I really believe if you will ask the Lord to reveal to you, and for you to write a family mission statement, a vision statement, and core values.

You say, "Great. I don't have a single family member right now that I think would be interested. Even if I took them to Hawaii, they wouldn't show up." Okay? No problem. You just work on this for you and let God create the interest in them.

Realize this, you may not be writing that to a family member right this moment. You may be writing it to a family member who will become extremely interested 10 years from now or 20 years from now, or in a generation you will never meet. So I want you to realize, by you writing this document you are setting the stage. You are laying the train tracks for the Kingdom of God to be accomplished in your family.

That was one great story that I got from one of the families that went through this. I also had an opportunity to take Family ID to India. I wanted to see how Family ID would translate into a completely different culture. Literally, it's a culture that is very family-oriented, where they arrange the marriages—even Christians. Christians and non-Christians arrange the marriages in that culture, and family is very important to them. They put a high premium on family and on family relationships, on taking care of your parents and taking care of your grandparents, and so on.

How would Family ID translate to them? I'm telling you, what God did for us in India has blown my mind. I don't know if I shared this story, but I took Family ID to India and shared this material with them. I came back from India, and I've been home about a month. I just was praying over the Great Commission and, "Lord, what did You have in mind when You said, 'Go and make disciples of every nation?' Is that something You wanted us to do in the first 500 years or the first 1,000 years? Or was that a 5,000-year plan and we're only 2,000 years into the plan? What did You have in mind for us?"

And I felt like the Lord began to give me this download, so I was sitting at my computer. Man, I'm telling you, the Lord spoke to me. It was 10:00 at night that I started typing into my notes, sitting up in my bed with my laptop on my lap, and I'm typing. I'm serious. From 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., I typed. So that's eight hours. For eight hours straight I typed into this revelation that God gave me. And what was His purpose? How did He want us to take the gospel of Jesus Christ to every nation, and how were we going to do it? What was the best method for that?

You know what? He revealed to me that His vision, the way we were going to do it was to disciple every generation of our family. See, we as parents and grandparents have influence over our children and our grandchildren—all of us. God will normally give us as believers enough time and live long enough that we can have influence over our children and grandchildren. Now because of the internet and the cloud, and the fact that we can record our voice and record our faces, man, we can influence great-, great-, great-, great-grandchildren 100 years from now, 1,000 years from now. So we now are one of the few generations that have ever lived that can document and put it electronically in a place where our children and grandchildren can access it, okay? So wow, wow. How awesome!

As I began to type, this is the download He gave me. Think about it: The king of the universe came to the earth through a family. Jesus could have come to the earth on a meteor. Think about how grand an entrance it would have been for Jesus Christ, the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, to come to the earth on a meteor. 2,000 years later, we could stand around the crater where He came to the earth and wonder at how awesome the king of the universe came to the earth on a meteor. What a grand entrance. He could've come to the earth on 10,000 tornadoes. Would you agree that

that would be a grand entrance if the King of kings came to the earth through a tornado? But He chose to come to the earth through a family.

Why is it that God has chosen to do, and to build His Kingdom with each one of us as His children? The question is, does God need children? No, He doesn't need children. He *wants* children. Right?

Hey, do *we* need children? If we're going to do this work of extending the Kingdom of God, if God wanted for the government to sit on His shoulders, for Him to bring salvation to all mankind, would He need us to do it with? No, but He *wanted* to do it with us, and you and I don't need children. Children take time and effort, *angst*. We don't need children, but we *want* children.

That's, I believe, what God is saying. The family was God's design. He wanted to be known as Father. The language of family is everywhere. The Church is the Bride of Christ. It's all about family, and God designed your family to bring salvation to this generation. God has designed the family to bring salvation and bring discipleship to every generation.

So that's why I think it is so vital that you lay the foundation for your family and your family vision by putting into writing this document and recording it, realizing that there is a generation, there is a descendant that is going to be so grateful. They're going to thank you 1,000 times over for taking the time, for making the effort, for putting up with the angst to invest in this, these most precious documents that you're going to pass to every generation.

I am excited. I've gotten so many different stories that I can share with you of families that have taken the Family ID course and they've shared with me years later, "Greg, I can't tell you. I didn't do everything that the Family ID material told me to do, but I did do three of those things, or I did two of them, and it has changed everything."

Here's what I'll tell you. **You go through this workshop, and I promise you can never do family like you've done in the past.** You'll never do it like that in the future because you will realize, "I can't do family by accident. I am now ruined, in a good way—that I just can't go back and try to do family by accident. I have got to do this now on purpose."

I'm just telling you the foundation of this vision, the foundation of this plan. When you write your family core values and you say, "Greg, it's just me. I'm somewhat by myself. My spouse, my spouse is no longer here," or whatever, no problem.

Listen, **the Holy Spirit wants to give you this download to help you to create this healthy family identity.** And you're going to pass to every generation this healthy Family ID, this family identity, because where family identity is strong, peer pressure is weak. Where family identity is weak, peer pressure is insurmountable—peer pressure is strong, okay? So you're building an insulation around your family. You're building an insulation around your grandchildren, your great-grandchildren. Generations from now will have this powerful insulation.

We can't isolate our families from the world. God didn't ask us to be isolators, to isolate from the world, okay? No, He wants you to go and build a powerful, impenetrable insulation to insulate them from the attacks of the world on your children, your grandchildren, and your great-grandchildren. So I want you to know, even if you say, "Greg, I don't have any children or grandchildren," no problem. If you, say, have got nieces and nephews that, if you were to write this document and pass it to them, get their opinion—oh my gosh, they're going to be so blessed.

Hey, if we found out had a great-uncle, a great-aunt that wrote a document, had a vision for us and was praying for us, are you kidding me? We'd count that the most valuable document in the world. So we are so excited, *I'm* so excited about Dr. Peck putting together this opportunity to help you put these documents in writing. I think it's truly going to be one of the most important things you'll ever do for your family. I'm so excited about that.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Thank you, Greg. Let's give [crosstalk 00:22:48] a big hand. Bonnie, you can spotlight me too. Keep Greg on there as well, so spotlight both of us. I'm going to be calling on some individuals to share, Bonnie. Then you can just spotlight the third person when they're sharing and remove them when they stop sharing.

Greg Gunn: Great.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Yeah, so this is so exciting. **What you're talking about, Greg, is God's dream for each family.** God has a dream, not just for individuals, but for each family.

And listen, when we get in touch with God's dream, then He gets in touch with us majorly. That's how we're going to experience favor.

God says in Psalm 133, "How blessed it is when people are in unity with one another, and from that place He is compelled to command a blessing." He can't hold it back from you—He must command His blessing. So when we get in unity as a family, He is compelled to command a blessing.

Well Greg, let me ask this question that Pam Gould asked. She said, "If I sign up for this," and she already has signed up for it, "How many of my family members can participate too at no cost?" Where's your heart with that, Greg?

Greg Gunn: Hey, I am wide open. If they would like to share that link with another family member, man, I'm wide open to that. I'll leave that up to you, Dr. Peck. How would that work?

Dr. Joseph Peck: Okay. Well, here's how it's work. Everyone that signs up for Family ID that's already signed up, you can invite your family members that want to be a part of this to it also.

Greg Gunn: Wow.

Dr. Joseph Peck: So that could be three people, it could be 10 people, it could be 50 people. The sky isn't the limit—the throne room is the limit.

Greg Gunn: Amen. Oh man, praise God.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Praise God.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Yeah, it's God's empowering grace. So is it a special deal? Yeah, it's not a two-for-one. It's not a three-for-one, it's a "bless your family as one," so that God is compelled to bless your family from a place of unity.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: So take our word for that.

Greg Gunn: Good word.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Okay. And Greg, you answered. Several people have said, "Well, **what if I'm single?**" If I'm a single mom, or single grandmother, or my spouse has gone to be with the Lord, or my spouse is no longer with me, **is this going to help my family move forward?**

Greg Gunn: Yes, yes. Oh, what a good word. Yes. In fact, I really believe that God has a very, very special blessing for those that are a part of a blended family or are a single parent or a single. God's calling on you to be single is so you can develop these documents and be very intentional about putting them in a place where your nieces, your nephews, your spiritual children can see them. Every one of us have children not born to us, and some of us do have children born to us. These are for your spiritual children. This is going to resonate in their spiritual DNA.

I'm telling you, this is so important that you get this. Don't ever think for one moment that you don't have children—you do. And Jesus said, "No person who has given up father or mother, brother or sister, houses and land, will not gain 100 times as much even in this life."

So here you are. You're saying, "Hey, I'm single." No, you're not. You're a brother or a sister to a ton of people. You're a spiritual father, a mother, a brother. You have a spiritual family that is so huge, you need to write this document for them. I really believe God has something very special, very special for those that are single or blended families. I'm serious. You're going to receive, I believe, a bonus blessing from God.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Amen. Thank you, Greg, and I agree completely.

Greg, the day after we did your free webinar on June 23rd, the morning afterwards I just received such a download from the Holy Spirit, and I journaled that. I told you it's worth more than \$1 million, but I'd sell it to you for \$100,000 because it really is worth it. This is going to multiply out.

But one of the things I wrote down in my journal the morning after you did the free webinar was to reach out to Pastor Rick Warren and ask him to watch the video replay. I'll ask him to watch that one, the one you did on June 23rd, and I'm going to

ask him to watch this one as well. He's passionate about purpose. He's passionate about people living their lives on purpose. But what I realized the next morning was He's going to be passionate about families living on purpose. He's going to get behind this, and He's going to multiply this throughout the churches.

Greg Gunn: Wow.

Dr. Joseph Peck: So I'm going to go ahead and just call on Lois Koss, who's my spiritual mother, to just pray, to just come on. Yeah, just unmute yourself, Lois. I want you to just pray about Pastor Rick Warren. Just come get a line in here with what the Holy Spirit is saying.

Lois Koss: Oh Father, you're a miracle-working God and this is not difficult for You. So I'm just asking You, prepare Pastor Rick for this communication, Lord. And that You would witness deep in His spirit, Lord, that would just quicken to him by the power of Your Holy Spirit.

Father, we thank You that You are a multiplier. We thank You that nothing is too good, too big for You. And so Lord, not only Pastor Rick Warren, but anybody else, Lord. We thank You that You're going to open doors that no man can close, Lord, that You are moving and that You're moving in families. And we give You praise and honor. Lord, we just praise You and we thank You with expectation of what You're doing. In Jesus' name, we give You glory. Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Amen.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Amen. **Bonnie, keep Lois on the screen here.** Barbara Nelson, I want you to come on the screen. Unmute yourself so you can just say hello to Greg, so she just recognizes you there.

Greg Gunn: Yes. Hey, Barbara.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Well, you can speak up there, Barbara. You can just speak up. And then Bonnie, you can just spotlight her too. Leave the four of us in there. Yeah, this is great. Yeah. I'm going to call on you, Barbara, in just a second. I want you to pray for someone else. But after I shared about Pastor Rick Warren in the Green Room to

Greg, he was telling me about his burden that he has for Tony Robbins. So I want you to just share that with our audience right now ...

Greg Gunn: Sure.

Dr. Joseph Peck: ... because we are all going to come into agreement with what the Holy Spirit is saying here.

Greg Gunn: Amen, amen. Yes. I really felt like God revealed to me, since I've met Dr. Peck and your incredible team, I just began to dream about, "Wow, I wonder how many other people have a following that consume the teachings and the training?" And the Lord just revealed to me that about Tony Robbins. I just started thinking about him and praying about him. And I started googling. Someone had said he'd done a family seminar, and so I googled Tony Robbins' family seminar, and I started trying to look. I found out that he's actually got material for how to raise kids that grow up to be world-changers, and how to develop this world-changing attitude inside your family.

Man, I was getting excited. I said, "Lord, would You open a door for me to meet with Tony Robbins, and for us to do a webinar helping families write their vision, mission, and values?"

Again, the majority of the people that consume Tony Robbins' material are probably non-believers, okay? So what an awesome opportunity to reveal to these people who don't know the things of God, are not walking with God, but for them to get this truth, because truth will set you free. And truth is a Person, not a thing. Truth is a Person.

Jesus said, "*I am the way, the truth. I am the truth.*" The truth is actually a Person. And so this truth could begin to go out to a million people, to five million people. I'm not sure how many followers Tony Robbins has, but it's in the millions. And if he got on this and got excited about it, man, can you imagine?

I've been thinking and praying about God providing a way for me to meet with these influencers, that these influencers would catch this vision and say, "You know what? I want everyone to have a family vision. I want everyone to have a family mission and these core values. I want to help my children and grandchildren. I want to help this generation to develop a vision that creates passion. And that passion creates

discipline, and that discipline creates total commitment, and that total commitment can change the world”.

So man, that is so exciting. I just thank you so much, Dr. Peck. For the Holy Spirit to have put Dr. Rick Warren on your mind is just like an answer to prayer that God would speak to you and give you this download. Oh, man, my heart is so encouraged with that news.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Amen. Well, **I actually had a chance to meet with Pastor Rick Warren at Saddleback Community Church** when I went there to be part of this Master Media International. Anyway, it's an organization that prays for the 1,000 most influential media leaders in the world. They got this network set up. The communications director had invited me and I actually stayed at the founder's home, and I didn't even know. I mean, I was staying at his place. I didn't even know where I was staying. I woke up the next morning, and it was the founder's home.

And anyway, then I got to go to this thing in Hollywood with my wife, and it was this prayer breakfast with these leaders. My wife had come for just a few days and she said, "Oh my gosh, that's so-and-so on TV."

Greg Gunn: Wow.

Dr. Joseph Peck: We had prime seating, and they were a table or two away from us, and she was excited.

Then while I was in that area, I ultimately went to Pastor Rick Warren's church. I got there early, and I was sitting on the front. He went ahead and preached. It was a great message. And then afterwards, he went out the side door. I wanted to go follow him, but someone who was new there wanted to talk to me. I wanted to just push them out of the way as I wanted to talk to Pastor Rick Warren, but I refrained from doing that and I talked to this guy. When I was done I went out a door, and there was Pastor Rick Warren and his wife, Kay! They were talking to people. There were maybe seven to 10 people, so I just got in line. I went up there and I talked to Kay. She had been diagnosed with cancer ...

Greg Gunn: Wow.

Dr. Joseph Peck: ... and asked me to pray for her. And then Pastor Rick Warren, he was amazing. I mean, here he just preached to tens of thousands of people in person, and then he got all the people virtually too ...

Greg Gunn: Right.

Dr. Joseph Peck: ... and then he's meeting with people. There were probably 50 people being baptized that day that had just given their hearts to the Lord. It was an amazing experience, so I'm talking to him. I don't know if he asked me for a business card, but I gave him a business card and it had my life slogan on it, "blessed to be a blessing." He says, "Oh, I love that." Well, I had gotten that from him. He had done a four-week teaching series called "Blessed to Be a Blessing." So of course he was going to love it ...

Greg Gunn: Oh, that's great.

Dr. Joseph Peck: ... but he has this ability to completely tune in to you, to listen with love, to be 100% present—not thinking about what he was going to do five minutes later, about other things that he said he was going to do. He was 100% present in his conversation with me. He's an extraordinarily gifted leader [inaudible 00:35:53] his influence. So anyway, he is going to say yes.

Now, Barbara Nelson, you just heard Greg's prayer request, so I want you to pray about Tony Robbins. Not just about him meeting with Greg, but about meeting with him and agreeing to do a webinar, because Tony Robbins might be the most influential person impacting the business mountain in the world.

So God—we're dreaming with God right now. This is not just a webinar, this is a Mastersmind marketing gathering. We're seeking the mind and heart of the Master together, and He's doing the marketing for us ...

Greg Gunn: Yes, yes.

Dr. Joseph Peck: ... the doors we could never open on our own. Thank You, Lord. Thank You, Holy Spirit. Go ahead, Barbara.

Barbara Nelson [PRAYER]: Lord, we just praise You for the joy and the energy that You have given us, Lord. We just choose to break forth into joy. [Singing.] And we just

call this meeting to come to fruition. We just say, 'Tony Robbins, meet with Greg.' God, in Jesus' name, we just say 'Let it be so.' And we send out the angels of God to tear through anything that would be stopping this. We just release angels of God to open the doors, to tear down anything standing in the way.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Barbara Nelson: And we just thank you that our God will make a way where there seems to be no way. We just bless this meeting. We thank You, Lord. We pray that You prepare their hearts, Lord. Prepare all the circumstances, the place where they meet.

Greg Gunn: Hallelujah.

Barbara Nelson: We just thank You. [foreign language 00:37:55]

Greg Gunn: Hallelujah. Hallelujah.

Barbara Nelson: We just say, 'Let it be.' Amen and hallelujah.

Greg Gunn: Amen. Amen.

Barbara Nelson: [inaudible 00:37:59].

Greg Gunn: Well, hey, I can't wait to tell you this story real quick. There was a person that was on our free webinar that we did a few weeks ago from Israel. They were on this webinar, they heard all about this. We just got a call from them this week and they said, "We are going to come. We're flying from Israel to the United States. We have a wedding that we are going to be attending." They're flying into Florida, then they're driving across the United States to somewhere—to Nevada or somewhere, "and we would like to meet with you, Greg, in Oklahoma City and talk to you about what we heard about Family ID."

Isn't that incredible? Oh, Dr. Peck, your influence is a global influence. Someone in Israel is going to meet with us, and I can't wait to share with them and just bless them. Oh, what a great opportunity. So man, thank you so much for all that each of you have done, all the prayers that each of you listening today have prayed for Empower 2000, to have the influence it has around the world. And man, I am actually a beneficiary of all of your hard work. Oh, praise God.

I also want to share, real quick, a story of a couple that took this idea of becoming intentional with their family. This was a couple who were not married yet, but they began to get excited about being intentional. So every Friday night this young girl would invite her fiancé to come over to her family's home and have dinner on Friday night. And every Friday night after dinner, they would go sit out on the front porch in the front porch swing and they would just dream about what they wanted their family to be like, and the things they wanted to do as a family. And as they would share, they would just begin to dream.

They just dreamed and dreamed. "These are the number of children we'd like to have. This is the kind of home we'd like to live in. These are the vacations we'd like to take. These are the things we would like to do," on and on and on. And then every night, when the young man would leave to go home, she would go into her room and write down everything they discussed week after week after week. She would write them in her journal, all of those dreams that they had.

Did you know that that couple then, every year on their anniversary, would pull that journal out? They would go over those dreams and relive those conversations they had as an engaged couple. And did you know that over a 25-year period, they lived out everything they wrote in that journal? Isn't that incredible?

I told you in our webinar that my grandfather John Diffy was one of the most influential men in my life. I mean, I'm telling you that to this day, I still think about how I want to be like my grandfather. He had this ability to make every grandchild feel like they were his favorite grandchild. We would even get into arguments as grandchildren, "I think I'm grandpa's favorite." And they'd go, "No, no, no, you're not. I am grandpa's favorite." "No, no. Really, I think I am."

Anyway, how did he have this ability? I don't know. I've been asking God to give me that ability. I want every one of my five grandchildren so far to think that they're my favorite, okay? My grandfather passed away when I was 12. Before he passed away, he could have said, "Greg, I want you to write some things down. Let's just discuss what kind of life you want to have. What kind of family do you want to have?"

If he and I would have sat down, I would have gotten my little pen out as a 12-year-old, and I would have scribbled down my answers. If he had initiated that, and I say that to all of you grandparents—I say that to all of you: You have this ability to sit

down and do what this little couple did, but in your own way, to help your children start dreaming—your grandchildren, your spiritual children and grandchildren. Help them become intentional, and they will never forget. They will never forget what you did for them in helping them to discover.

Now, you're going to say, "They don't have any idea what kind of ..." "Hey, don't you want one day to marry someone who has a heart for God?" "Yeah, yeah." "Okay, write that down. Hey, don't you one day want to be in a position to own a business so that you could have the ability to create jobs, jobs that provide income for families? Jobs that provide so that someone can send their children to school and so on?"

I mean, you can help lead that conversation as to what kind of life they would like to live. And I'm telling you, that document will become the most valuable thing, the most valuable tool.

Hey, parents, grandparents, single parents, I want you to realize you've got a powerful, powerful ability to impact and help your family to become dreamers, to become. Look, the sky's the limit. Hey, if we're making this up, let's make it up good, okay? That's what's so beautiful about your influence, in how God's going to help you and me become more intentional this year than we were last year, more intentional today than I was yesterday. So man, what a great, great word.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Wow Greg, you fired me up, and I already was fired up. I'm really glowing in the dark on the inside here.

Greg Gunn: That's great.

Dr. Joseph Peck: I was talking to Virginia Morton yesterday, who participated in the Pray Culpeper Group. She was one of our core team members for two years. Back in 2005 to 2007 she wrote the book called **Marching Through Culpeper: A Civil War Novel**, that we know is going to be turned into a major motion picture that's more popular than *Gone With the Wind*. It's already been turned into a stage play, but-

Greg Gunn: Oh, man.

Dr. Joseph Peck: I was talking to her yesterday, and she was just sharing about my connecting gift. She said, "Joseph, there were seven of us that went to Montpelier,"

the home of James Madison, which is about 40 minutes from where I live. She said they did some prophetic acts there. And she said, "Joseph, all the other six people that came, the common link was you—even though they came from different places, they all knew you."

I'm hearing, as I'm listening to you, Greg, "Yeah, **I'm going to ask Dr. Joseph Umidi to watch the video** that we did on June 23rd. He's the founder of Lifeforming Leadership Coaching. He's trained 10,000 leadership coaches. I'm one of the 10,000, and he's Executive Vice President of Regent University. He meets with Pat Robertson and Gordon Robertson every week. I'm going to ask him to watch the videos and ask him to **open the door for you to be on CBN, the Christian Broadcasting Network** which is on the campus there.

Greg Gunn: Wow. Praise God. Praise God.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Yeah.

Greg Gunn: What a beautiful vision.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Yeah. My mandate is to power-network God's army around the world, to network the networks, and so I'm just going to use that gift. Listen, you are watching. People of God, you're watching what it's like to dream with God.

Greg was just sharing his dream, his dream for what God's called him to do. So I'm going to ask Barbara right now, do you have any questions you'd like to share with Greg or any thoughts you'd like to share with your own family? Or it could be your spiritual family, or whatever. Any thoughts you have?

Barbara Nelson: I just really appreciate what you guys are doing. I think it's really needed right now.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Barbara Nelson: And I guess, "**What would be one thing that we can do to start?**" That might be my question, "What should we do to begin?"

Greg Gunn: Yes, and I really believe that **the next step is for you to write down the names of each of your family members and let God just speak through the end of**

your pen. Of course start with your closest family members. Then begin to pray over that list, that God would prepare their heart to hear this information, that God would prepare them for you meeting with them and just doing some things that are intentional with your family.

That was something God really convicted me about, that I have cousins and nieces, not really nieces and nephews. I have cousins that I know are not walking with God, and I was not praying for them—I wasn't. I didn't have a purposeful prayer life, prayer time where I actually prayed for them on any kind of a regular basis. So I thought, "You know what? I don't even know all their names."

So I actually started calling cousins who might know other cousins' names. I've got the list inside my phone. I've got it, and I made a family list of all cousins. And then one of my other cousins, his name is Cort Diffy. Of course, we have the same grandfather, John Diffy. And so Cort and I started praying every Sunday morning at 7:00 in the morning before he went to church. We would pray down through the list of all of our cousins, our cousins and their kids and who their kids married, and how old they are, and how many kids. I'm serious. We have got an extensive list of family members.

I'm just going to **encourage you to start praying specifically that God would begin to stir up the vision.** He would stir up the vision inside of them because that is what is going to capture the heart and the imagination of our spiritual family. You have spiritual children that God has put in your life, so you can start this with them as well. Again, it all starts with your personal vision.

I think it's you praying that God will stir up the vision in you, and that your vision will impact and affect and infect them like a good, godly virus, okay? Like a godly virus, man, it's just going to get passed around and it's going to bring healing—a virus that brings healing. Hallelujah!

I really believe that's your first step. And God, the Holy Spirit, because you hear from God. I know you do, Barbara—you know His voice. And there's all of you. All of you have been trained to hear God's voice. So He will then begin to speak more in other things, more specific things for you to pray off the oppression that might be on a family member, to pray against the principalities, the powers, the spiritual wickedness in high places. You'll begin to pray those forces away and off so that the

Holy Spirit can speak directly into them and into you, helping you write these documents.

Seriously, I see each one of you putting your pen down on a piece of paper as you go through this process of developing your vision, mission, and values. I see you just putting your pen on your paper and the Holy Spirit speaking through the end of your pen, okay?

You're just going to look at your page and go, "Oh my gosh, look what's coming out of the end of my pen." All right? You're going to experience that supernatural prompting. Just like the authors of God's Word were, you're writing out God's Word for your family and for your future generations.

Would someone look up these two scriptures? I'd love for several of you to do it in different translations. It's Psalm 112:1–3. So if someone would look that one up, and then Psalm 25:12–13, so if you would look those up. These are words, these are scriptures for your future generations. These are scriptures you can pray over your future generation. Is there someone who could look up Psalm 112:1–3?

Then if someone would share the version that you have there, and then someone else share the same scripture, but maybe in a different version. Let's see if we can get some deep understanding of these two scriptures. I think it will be a real blessing.

And then someone else, another scripture that just came to me, it's Isaiah 54:13. Would someone look those up? Who has the Psalm 112 scripture that you can share? Okay, I see one, Freddie. Freddie, would you, can you? Yes.

Freddie: Thank you. Can you hear me?

Greg Gunn: Yes, we can hear you.

Freddie: This is from the New Living Translation (NLT).

Greg Gunn: Okay, good.

Freddie: First one. *Praise the Lord. Happy are those who fear the Lord. Yes, happy are those who delight in doing what He commands. Their children will be successful*

everywhere. An entire generation of godly people will be blessed. They themselves will be wealthy and their good deeds will never be forgotten.

Greg Gunn: Wow. Wow. Wow. My goodness. What did that say about our children? Freddie, what does it say? That our children will be what?

Freddie: *Successful everywhere.*

Greg Gunn: Glory to God. Can you imagine speaking that over your children? They'll be successful everywhere. What does it say about wealth and riches? What will happen? What about wealth and riches?

Freddie: It says they themselves will be wealthy and their good deeds will never be forgotten.

Greg Gunn: Wow, wow. What a blessing. What a promise, oh my goodness. Hey, does someone else have another translation that you looked that up in? Yes, Barbara.

Barbara Nelson: This is the Tree of Life Translation.

Greg Gunn: Okay.

Barbara Nelson: *Hallelujah. "Happy is the man who fears out Adonai, who delights greatly in His commands. His offspring will be mighty in the land. The generation of the upright will be blessed. Wealth and riches are in his house. And his righteousness endures forever."*

Greg Gunn: Wow. His offspring will be what?

Barbara Nelson: Blessed.

Greg Gunn: Blessed. They'll be mighty in the land.

Barbara Nelson: Mighty in the land.

Greg Gunn: What does it mean to be mighty in the land? The people who are mighty in the land have what positions?

Barbara Nelson: They're at the top.

Greg Gunn: Exactly. They're the ones that run successful businesses. These are the ones who are presidents of colleges, presidents of universities. These are mayors, these are governors, these are those who are mighty in the land. Wow, what a translation, what a nuance. They'll be successful everywhere, they'll be mighty in the land. Is there another? Let's do one more translation of Psalm 112. One more translation.

Audience: Joseph, I have what 112 says in the Passion Translation.

Greg Gunn: Okay, okay.

Audience: *“Shout in celebration of praise to the Lord. Everyone who loves the Lord and delights in Him will cherish His words and be blessed beyond expectation. Their descendants will be prosperous and influential. Every generation of His godly lovers will experience His favor. Great blessing and wealth fills the house of the wise, for their integrity endures forever.”*

Greg Gunn: Man, oh man. Talk about another beautiful facet, looking at this beautiful diamond, looking at these different facets of Psalm 112 and the blessing that's being poured out on our future generations. I'm telling you, that whole chapter is something I would ask each of you to consider making your family chapter. There are 10 verses. We have 10 fingers, 10 toes. This is 10 verses that are power-packed. And look at it in all these different translations. Let the Holy Spirit help you to create your own version. Oh, man, I love it. I love it.

Okay, does anyone have Psalm 25:12,13? Would someone read Psalm 25:12,13? Who would read that one? Somebody raise their hand. Psalm 25:12,13—let's get another powerful word here. Anyone? Okay, great. Paulette, I see you, yes.

Paulette: Yes, I have it in the New King James Version.

Greg Gunn: Okay. Beautiful.

Paulette: *“Who is the man that fears the Lord? Him shall He teach in the way He chooses. He himself shall dwell in prosperity, and his descendants shall inherit the earth.”*

Greg Gunn: Wow. Wow. His descendants, He himself will dwell in what?

Paulette: Prosperity.

Greg Gunn: Wow, and his-

Paulette: [[crosstalk 00:58:39](#)].

Greg Gunn: ... descendants ...

Paulette: Shall inherit the earth.

Greg Gunn: Wow, shall inherit the earth. What does it mean to inherit the earth? Wow, beautiful, beautiful. Anyone else? Is there another translation? How about that New Living Translation? Freddie, do you have that in Psalm 25?

Freddie: I do.

Greg Gunn: Okay.

Freddie: Here it is. Verse 12. *“Who are those who fear the Lord? He will show them the path they should choose. They will live in prosperity, and their children will inherit the Promised Land.”*

Greg Gunn: Praise God. Praise God.

Paulette: Amen.

Greg Gunn: “Your descendants will inherit the Promised Land.” What promises has God given to you? They will get to inherit even your promises, your Promised Land. Hallelujah, hallelujah.

Paulette: Amen.

Greg Gunn: A godly man and woman leave an inheritance to their who?

Paulette: Children, and their children's children.

Greg Gunn: Yes, I love it. I love it. This spiritual inheritance that you're going to leave them—oh, my goodness, this is getting exciting. Anyone else? One other.

Paulette: I have a Passion.

Greg Gunn: Okay. It would be great.

Paulette: It says, “*Who are they that live in the holy fear of Yahweh? You will show them the right path to take, then prosperity and favor will be their portion, and their descendants will inherit the earth.*”

Greg Gunn: Wow. How many agree, **owning real estate is a good investment?** Would you all agree with that? Can you imagine getting to inherit the whole earth? Man, that's even more than the cattle on 1,000 hills. Would you all agree with that? Inheriting the earth—man, I love it.

Hey, would someone read Isaiah 57? Isaiah 54? Isaiah 54:13, would someone look it up in the Amplified Classic, AMPC? The Amplified Classic, if somebody would look that up. And then would anyone else, would you read us a version, in the version there that you have? Someone read Isaiah 54:13. Man, this is getting exciting. Who's got that?

Barbara Nelson: I could read it in the Tree of Life version.

Greg Gunn: Okay. Okay, good.

Barbara Nelson: “*All your children will be taught by Adonai; your children will have great Shalom.*”

Greg Gunn: Wow. Wait, wait. Read that again. How many of our children?

Barbara Nelson: *All* your children.

Greg Gunn: Wait, wait—how many is all?

Barbara Nelson: *All.*

Greg Gunn: Man, that's a lot. Would you all agree with that?

Paulette: I've got the Amplified.

Greg Gunn: Okay, good. Good.

Paulette: Classic.

Greg Gunn: Amplified-

Paulette: It's my fave, besides Passion. Verse 13 says, "*And all your ...*" And actually, it says, "*spiritual children*" in parentheses, "*will be disciples,*" and then in parentheses, "*taught by the Lord and obedient to His will,*" parentheses, "*and grace shall be the peace and undisturbed composure of your children.*"

Greg Gunn: Wow. Wow. Wait a minute. It says, *all* of your children. Even spiritual children will be disciples, taught by who?

Paulette: Taught by the Lord, and obedient to His will. That's one of my faves that I stand on for my own. Yep.

Greg Gunn: Wow.

Paulette: "*Great shall be the peace and undisturbed composure of your children.*"

Greg Gunn: Wow. How could there be anything so beautiful? Thank you, Lord. Oh my goodness, what a good word for each of us to stand on these scriptures for all of our future generations. Our children, grandchildren, great grandchildren. Oh my goodness, for us to become families who are living on purpose. Oh my goodness, this could revolutionize the entire earth if every one of us stood on these powerful words for our children and grandchildren and great-grandchildren, that they'll be wealthy and rich. Man, are you kidding me? Yes, wealth without sorrow, oh my goodness. How wonderful. Oh, I love it. Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Wow, this is amazing. There's Bible studies, and then there's Bible studies. We just been at a second, where the Holy Spirit is orchestrating this. I didn't know how this conversation was going to go, except I knew, beyond a shadow of a doubt that I needed to keep my word to host another Q&A webinar about Family ID.

Now Heather Harris, who's writing the Sabbath Inspirations for me in my voice so it sounds like I'm writing them—and I *am* writing them; she's writing them on my behalf—she was asking, "What's the subject title for this Saturday, two days from now?" Well, I still didn't have it. So I was asking the Lord, "What's going to be the subject title? I'll let her watch it and come up with a subject title. We're sending that

to 40,000 people on Saturday, and she'll take notes. We're going to go ahead and send more people to it.”

Hey listen, if they want to unsubscribe, that's okay. We're going to let the people who are hearing the voice of Spirit listen to the ...

Greg Gunn: Hallelujah.

Dr. Joseph Peck: The Bible says numerous times, *Selah*. And by the way, everyone who's signed up for Family ID is going to receive, as an extra bonus that's not even announced, so those are people who previously signed up, and those who do, they will receive **The Nature of Truth** by James Goll, which is a message he released in December of 2020. Now I just was led, because we're making a special bonus. And by the way, Greg, you were talking about the pen, writing it down, and just the scripture that we released this morning for the class that we're doing about The Discerner with James Goll—I'm going to do this, the scripture here. Bear with me for a second while I bring it up.

Greg Gunn: Yeah.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Okay. *My tongue is the pen of the ready writer.*

Paulette: Writer.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Psalm 45:1.

Greg Gunn: Wow. Wow.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Barbara, you asked such a great question. "What is the first step to begin?" And then you've talked about, "your pen is going to start to just flow." All right?

Greg Gunn: Amen. I love it. I love it. I love it.

Dr. Joseph Peck: **So your tongue is going to follow your pen.** Write the vision and make it plain. Listen, if you receive that email from me, I encourage all of you to read it. What if one simple step could exponentially increase your discernment? That was a subject title of the email. I'll put it in the chat here, so you've got it. I encourage all of you to read it carefully, because we have scriptures that are related to that.

Greg Gunn: Oh, amen. Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Yeah. Okay, yeah. I'm going to put that scripture in there as well. "My tongue is the pen of a ready writer," so this is spiritual sparking.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Dr. Joseph Peck: This is one person sharing something, and then another person sharing something, and then-

Greg Gunn: Praise God. Praise God.

Dr. Joseph Peck: God just igniting a fire. So you're just watching, and in a year from now we're going to all look back. You will have been on this call, as well as those that watch the replay, and we're going to say, "Oh my gosh, I remember this day."

Now what was yesterday, by the way? When we scheduled this webinar in obedience to the Holy Spirit, yesterday was 7-7-21. 21 is three 7's.

Greg Gunn: Wow. Wow.

Dr. Joseph Peck: So seven is a number for perfection, and 777 is a number for divine perfection. I don't know what five 7's is, but anyway, it's even better. So this is fruit of obedience, fruit of obedience.

Greg Gunn: Yes. Yes.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Listen, I had other things that I needed to get done in Joseph's plan for the day. But in God's plan, it was to release this message today. And He's going to use this, Greg, because you were sharing from your heart. And just that story, He's going to multiply this. And when you were talking about that judge, you know what I was hearing in my spirit? That God is going to use that message, that story, the testimony of that judge, to multiply it in judges throughout the earth. Praise the Lord.

Greg Gunn: Praise the Lord.

Dr. Joseph Peck: I'm just sharing what I'm seeing, what I'm hearing.

Greg Gunn: That's so good. That's so good.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Yeah, it's good to dream with God.

Greg Gunn: Thank you, Lord. Thank you, Lord. Yes, yes.

Dr. Joseph Peck: So, thank you everyone who has signed up for Family ID. And for those of you who haven't signed up, if you're interested—hopefully you are interested—then go to familyid777.com.

By the way, here's another bonus. We said you can invite your family members, your natural family members. There's no limit to that. You can go all the way back to Noah. That's a lot of people.

Greg Gunn: Hallelujah. Oh, I love it.

Dr. Joseph Peck: But you can also invite your spiritual children and grandchildren. So if you're a spiritual mother or father for someone and you've paid to sign up for the class, you can give a scholarship. So I'll send a follow-up email to you, how you get a scholarship, okay?

Greg Gunn: That's great. That's great.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Hey, listen. The spirit of generosity is flowing. It's a river of generosity—the river of your vision.

Greg Gunn: Praise God.

Dr. Joseph Peck: I am so with you, Greg.

Greg Gunn: Thank you, thank you, thank you. I'm so grateful for all of you. You guys have no idea. You are such a refreshing, you're a refreshing well of water. I thank you. Thank you, thank you each one of you. Thank you.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Okay, I am going to call on Shelli here, because I know Shelli's spirit has to be leaping for joy a little bit.

Shelli Miller: I am just beside myself with excitement about this because, I mean, all these connections that are being prayed into existence since we've been on this call together, it can't even be quantified. This is going to be so enormous in affecting the world that we can't even grasp it at this moment.

And then Barb asked the inspired question about, “well, how do we start?” And then that leads into all of this about how it's so much bigger. We were all thinking immediate family, right? Or maybe our first cousins, and some people have a lot of those, like Greg. And some of us just have a few, but this goes on, and on, and on in the life of the Word of God being spoken through these various translations. I mean, just having that spoken right there went out over our families, okay? Every family represented here received life from these scriptures being read aloud.

Greg Gunn: Wow. Wow.

Shelli Miller: That is exciting. Folks, I don't care if you have to hog-tie them and drag them to the computer to get them on the Zoom. Do it.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Shelli Miller: Do it. This is important. It's just bigger, more enormous than I could have imagined. And that's happening every time we get together.

Greg Gunn: Yes.

Shelli Miller: The LORD is moving in ways. I look back at years gone by, it was boring compared to this. We thought we were really getting with it in Christ, and it was boring compared to what's happening now. So thank You, Lord. Thank You for Your multiplication in this, for Your networking, for Your connections, for Your favor being poured out upon it.

Lord, we used to get a good idea and ask You to bless it, but now You are giving us the ideas, and they come along with Your blessing and favor as part of the package deal. And we just thank You. Thank You for the flow of Your Holy Spirit over all of it, that people in our families that we never imagined would pay any attention are going to sit up and say, "What's that you're talking about? That's pretty interesting. Tell me some more." And they're going to come into Christ, they're going to come into their purpose, they're going to come into the Kingdom.

And Lord, I just thank You that there is change—massive, massive change of the righteous sort—happening even now as we're together. We're going to come out here and start discovering things. Maybe not today or tomorrow, but we're going to find out. "You know what? That happened on"—what's today? July 8th or something? "That happened on July 8, 2021, and we didn't even know what then. This is big. This is exciting. Thank you, Greg. Thank you, Joseph. Thank you everyone who read. Oh, all those different translations, was that beautiful or what?"

Greg Gunn: That was so good.

Shelli Miller: And the power of it. The power just rocked and rolled.

Greg Gunn: Amen. Amen.

Shelli Miller: This is so big. It's so big. Okay. I'll stop. Thank you.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Thank you. Let's give Shelli Miller a hand here. That was our closing prayer.

Shelli Miller: Oh.

Dr. Joseph Peck: Yeah, and we are going to have Shelli Miller lead us in saying good-bye the Empowered way.

Shelli Miller: Okay, if anyone is new, just follow along. Okay? This is what we do in Empower 2000 in our virtual world. We say good-bye with a virtual Empower 2000 hug.

Greg Gunn: Amen.

Shelli Miller: Okay? And then we give an Empowered virtual kiss. And then we give an Empowered virtual wave. Shalom. Shalom to everyone!

Greg Gunn: Shalom.

Shelli Miller: Shalom. Shalom. We love you.

Greg Gunn: We love you.

Shelli Miller: Better and better. All right. Thank you, Jesus. Thank you, Jesus.

Greg Gunn: Thank You. Thank You.

Shelli Miller: Glory to God. Blessings!

Greg Gunn: Thank You, Lord.

Shelli Miller: Thanks for being here today.

Greg Gunn: Thank you.

Shelli Miller: If you're not signed up, we know you will be in a minute. Okay, blessings. Thank you!
